Location & Description

Location

Highbridge is a market town located in the Sedgemoor district of Somerset. Being well served by junction 22 of the M5. Highbridge is within commuting distance of Bristol (30 miles), Taunton (20 miles), Bridgwater (8 miles) Weston-super-Mare (10 miles) and the Hinkley Point power station (18 miles).

Highbridge & Burnham railway station provides direct services to Taunton (22 minutes), Exeter St David's (55 minutes) and Bristol Temple Meads (44 minutes) stations. Regular services to London Paddington are available from Taunton and Bristol Temple Meads, with the fastest total journey time being 2 hours 14 minutes.

Highbridge has a population of approximately 7,500 and the town centre has a good range of local amenities including an Asda Superstore, Co-Operative Food, Lloyds Pharmacy and Post Office.

Highbridge is adjacent to Burnham-on-Sea, a popular holiday destination providing a range of leisure and recreation facilities, such as hotels, restaurants and a golf course.



Description

The 2.7 ha (6.7 acre) site is accessed from the town centre via Tyler Way and Newton Road and comprises three light industrial buildings and extensive hard standing, currently used for open storage / car parking. Vacant possession will be provided upon completion of any sale.

The surrounding locale is predominantly residential, with a recently completed housing development bordering the site to the south.

The 42 acre Apex Wildlife & Leisure Park is located to the North West of the site and provides a children's play area, skate park and fishing facilities.

The principle of building 102 units (a mix of 2 -4 bedroom houses and some apartments) has been established via an indicative masterplan which accompanies the planning permission. It may be possible to increase the number of units by way of a reserved matters application.
